PRESS RELEASE

As a demonstration of India's steadfast dedication to eradicating terrorism, a multiparty parliamentary delegation led by Member of Parliament Ms. Kanimozhi Karunanidhi engaged in high-level discussions during their official visit to the Hellenic Republic. The delegation met with senior officials from Greece's Ministry of Foreign Affairs, including Deputy Minister Mr. Tasos Chatzivasileiou, key members of the Greek Parliament, leading policy experts, and the media.

In a focused session with members of the Greece-India Parliamentary Friendship Group and the Committee on Defense and Foreign Affairs, the Indian delegation underscored New Delhi's uncompromising approach toward terrorism. They firmly conveyed that there can be no differentiation between terrorist actors and those who abet or shelter them. The Indian side called for Greece's backing in ensuring accountability for those who orchestrate, carry out, or fund such acts of violence.

During the meeting with Deputy Minister Chatzivasileiou, the delegation provided a comprehensive briefing on the brutal terrorist strike in Pahalgam, detailing India's proportionate and restrained reaction. They emphasized India's unwavering determination to eliminate the scourge of terrorism through strategic and deliberate measures.

4. The delegation also convened with leaders and representatives from leading Greek think tanks. These dialogues centered around India's recalibrated counter-terrorism stance—characterized by prompt and resolute action that holds both terrorists and their enablers equally responsible.

5. Addressing prominent media outlets, the delegation reiterated India's firm anti-terrorism doctrine. They highlighted that Operation Sindoor was a justified and deliberate step taken in direct response to the attack, aligning with India's principles of calibrated justice. It was stressed that terrorism is a global menace and that the international community must unite in facing this common threat.

6. Concluding the day's engagements, the delegation interacted with members of the Indian community in Greece. The diaspora expressed their full support for India's efforts and solidarity with the nation in the wake of the recent tragic events.
