Respected Sir,

I am glad to inform that the 5th edition of Pariksha Pe Charcha, the unique interactive program of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi with students, teachers and parents will be held **through virtual mode in February 2022**. This event was organized successfully for the last four years by the Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education.

2. We are keen for the embassies under your Ministry to become a part of this much-awaited and joyful event. In order to select participants who will be featured in Pariksha Pe Charcha programme, an online creative writing competition is being conducted at <https://www.mygov.in/on> various topics (Annexure-I) during **28th December to 20th January 2022** for children studying in classes of 9 to 12, teachers and parents. About 2050 winners will also receive a certificate signed by Director, NCERT and a special PPC Kit comprising of Exam Warriors book in Hindi and English, written by Hon'ble Prime Minister.

3. The competitions are the mode through which we invite students, parents and teachers to frame their questions to be addressed to the Hon'ble Prime Minister. This year the competition is open for foreign students too. Selected questions, shortlisted by NCERT, may feature in the programme. The participants who asked questions in the previous editions of Pariksha Pe Charcha are invited by media channels to appear in their programmes. In the same lines this year's chosen few may get an opportunity to interact with media.

4. In this context you are requested to kindly arrange the following:

a. **Appoint a Nodal Officer**, not below the rank of Director, to liaise with my office for the purpose of this event.

b. **Issue instructions to display creatives** (*soft copies of the creatives will be shared shortly*) on:

- official websites of your Ministry and its associated offices/departments,
- prominent locations in all subordinate offices at various levels,
- prominent places in all the embassies and other institutions functioning under the aegis of your Ministry
- Moreover, you may adopt other innovative measures to propagate and promote this significant initiative of Hon'ble Prime Minister towards reducing exam stress.

c. Ensure all **creatives and directions are sent through email and social media to all your schools and educational administrators through your office**, and through schools to all parents/students.

d. Please ensure maximum registration by students/parents in embassies/institutions under your Ministry in the online creative writing competition being conducted at <https://www.mygov.in/> from 28th December 2021 to 20th January 2022 to avail of the chance of being selected for this event.

e. The following hashtag is to be used for disseminating this event: #PPC2022.



For PPC 2022, suggested list of themes is presented below:

- *Themes for Students:*
 - a. Exam stress management strategies during COVID-19:
Creative strategies adopted by you as a student to manage pandemic stress and forthcoming exam stress.
 - b. Azadi Ka Amrit Mahostav:
Do you know about the history of the village/town/city where you live? Write about your village, town, or city, and share about an unknown facet of the freedom struggle there.
 - c. Self-reliant School for Self-reliant India:
What does self-reliance mean to you? Share your ideas on making you and your teachers "Atmanirbhar" in-terms of teaching and learning when the schools are not fully functional due to COVID-19.
 - d. Clean India, Green India:
Your ideas on how to strengthen India's fight against climate change.
 - e. Digital Collaboration in Classrooms:
How your teacher made your online class joyful, interesting and effective during the pandemic. Your views on how quality of online classes can be improved.
 - f. Environmental conservation and climate change resilience:
Activities undertaken by you as a student during pandemic period for Environmental conservation and climate change.
- *Themes for Teachers:*
 - a. National Education Policy (NEP) for *Naya Bharat*:
How provisions of National Education Policy will empower student's lives in particular and society in general, and pave way for "*Naya Bharat*".
